Strategic Interaction: Rolecards

Stunde 1

Role A:

You are the owner of a bakery. One of your specialities is low-calory sweets. Unfortunately, you've sold your entire supply for the day. The only remaining sweets are the fattening ones. Someone comes to buy sweets. Prepare yourself to sell the ones you have.

Role B:

The doctor has put you on a strict diet. You must not eat high-calory desserts. You have seen an ad in the paper about a bakery where low-calory sweets are sold. You would like to eat something sweet but not with a lot of calories.

What will you ask the baker to be certain that the advertised sweets are not fattening?

A diet

Roles A and B: You have been put on a diet by your doctor. Each must lose 15 pounds. The doctor weighs each of you every two weeks. You are asked to give a reason for the weight that you have got, both to your doctor and to your friend.

Be prepared to talk with your partner (A or B)!

A: Original weight - 150
first two weeks - 145
second two weeks - 146

B: Original weight - 152
first two weeks - 143
second two weeks - 141

Stunde 2

Role A: You are watching a good movie on TV, but it is getting late and your mother wants you to go to bed. What will you say to her to convince her to let you continue watching TV?

Role B: Your child stays up late to watch TV whenever she/he has the chance to do so. She/he must go to bed in order to be wide awake the next day. What will you say to make your child go to bed?

Role A: You have a lot of homework to do, but you want to go to the cinema with friends. (It has all been arranged for a week). What will you say to your father to convince him to let you go?

Role B: Your child has brought home some bad marks on tests lately. Now she/he wants to go to the cinema and asks your permission. What will you do?

Stunde 3

Scenario: Surprise! Surprise!

Role A: You are preparing for a very important exam which will be given tomorrow. It is evening and your friend calls you to invite you over for a while. What will you do? Should you keep studying? Do you need a break? You know that this friend loves to talk and may keep you there for hours.

Role B: It is close to the end of the school year and today is the birthday of your friend (A). You and your other friends have organized a surprise birthday party for A. You know that A may be studying for an exam, but it is your job to call him or her up and invite him or her over to your place, where the party will be. Of course, you must not tell him or her a word about the party!

Scenario: The Babysitter

Role A: You are a teenager. You have been offered your first babysitting job. You really want the money. Your mother has to give her permission. Discuss it with her.

Role B: Your teenager has been offered a babysitting job. It will be his or her first job - if you give your permission. Will you do so? There is an important test coming up at school tomorrow.
